You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals!

TSR Riders Finals – 1st & 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the ring.

Class 1 - Novice horse - 2ft 3ins - 2ft 6ins Class 2 - Intermediate - 2ft 6ins - 2ft 9 ins Class 3 - Large M&M - 2ft 9ins - 3ft Class 4 - <u>THE STOKES FAMILY / OPEN WORKING HUNTER</u> Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms. Riders of stallions to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Maximum height of fences 1.14m (3'9") at the discretion of the Judges.

(LUNCH BREAK)

Class 5 - Lead rein pony: Rider 8 Years and under - 1ft (Assisted)

Class 6 - Cradle Stakes: Rider 10 and under - 1ft - 1ft 3ins

Class 7 - NEDZ / EQUIFEST MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND WORKING HUNTER PONIES

Mountain and Moorland Working Hunter pony, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dartmoor, Dales, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland or Welsh A, B, C or D. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Riders any age.

Class 8 - KBIS / EQUIFEST WORKING HUNTER PONIES

Working Hunter Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cms. Riders must be the correct age for the animal they ride. If this classification is run as one class, fences must be adjusted for each height section. Classes may be divided as follows:

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 133cms. Riders not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 133cms but not exceeding 143cms. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 143cms but not exceeding 153cms. Riders not to have attained their 20th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- Open Intermediate Working Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years or over, exceeding 148cms and not exceeding 158cms. Riders not to

have attained their 25th birthday before $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$ January in the current year.

MARKING AND JUMPING PENALTY POINTS for Non-Equifest qualifiers:

- First Refusal = 15 Penalties
- Second Refusal = 20 Penalties
- Third Refusal = Elimination
- Knock Down = 10 Penalties
- Phase 1: Jumping =50% / Style And Manners =10%
- Phase 2: Conformation & Freedom Of Action =30% / Manners = 10%

Championship to follow for 1st & 2nd placed.

No spurs to be used by junior competitors.

One fall of horse or rider will result in instant elimination and you will be asked to leave the ring unmounted.

RING 2 RIDDEN

Classes to commence at 10am

Class 1 - Best Turned out - Any height/Any age

Class 2 - <u>DAVEY'S LIVESTOCK TRANSPORT LTD /EQUIFEST SHOW</u> <u>PONY LEAD REIN</u>: Leading Rein Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 8th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.

Class 3 - <u>CAVERNOMA ALLIANCE UK / EQUIFEST MOUNTAIN &</u> <u>MOORLAND LEAD REIN</u>

Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland and Welsh A or B. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a Snaffle Bridle, the lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.

Class 4 - "First time off Lead Rein" Parents may stand in the ring (Riders may not compete in any other ridden class "off the lead-rein")

Class 5 - <u>SNUGGY HOODS / EQUIFEST SHOW PONY FIRST RIDDEN</u> First Ridden Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cm. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle.

Class 6 - RUBY MARITIME SERVICES / EQUIFEST RIDDEN SHOW PONIES

Open Show Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 148cms. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Classes may be divided.

Class 7 - Small M + M

Class 8 - EQUIFEST RIDDEN PART BREDS

Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Exhibits in this section must be registered in the Part Bred section of their respective Breed Society. Registration numbers must be stated on the entry form. Horses and ponies will not be ridden at the final. Riders any age. Classes may be divided as appropriate.

Class 9 - Open ridden Coloured/ Spotted / Palomino

Class 10 - KBIS / EQUIFEST RIDDEN SHOW HUNTER PONIES

Show Hunter Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cms. Riders not to have attained their 20th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Classes may be divided as follows:

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 122cms but not exceeding 133cms. Riders not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year
 - Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 133cms but not exceeding 143cms. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
 - Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 143cms but not exceeding 153cms. Riders not to have attained their 20th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 11 - <u>T WALKER HGV / EQUIFEST SHOW HUNTER PONY- LEAD</u> <u>REIN Show Hunter Pony</u> - Lead Rein, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Rider not to have attained their 9th Birthday before 1st January in the current year.

(Championship to follow for 1st & 2nd placed. To be followed by a lunch break).

Class 12 - NUPAFEED / EQUIFEST RIDING HORSES

Open Riding Horse, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, any height. Riders any age. Classes may be divided as follows:

- Small Riding Horses mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders any age.
- Large Riding Horses mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 158cms. Riders any age.

Class 13 <u>BLACK COUNTRY SADDLES / EQUIFEST RIDDEN HUNTERS</u> <u>Open Ridden Hunter</u>

mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 153cms. Riders any age. Classes may be divided as follows:

- Lightweight Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, capable of carrying up to 12.7stone.
- Middleweight Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, capable of carrying 12.7 stone but not 14 stone.
- Heavyweight Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over capable of carrying over 14 stone.

Class 14 - BSPA / EQUIFEST RIDDEN PIEBALD / SKEWBALD

Open ridden Piebald / Skewbald stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. Riders any age. The first three places will also qualify for the BSPA Championship. Subject to their show rules & conditions. Classes may be divided according to entries.

Class 15 - THE HEWITT FAMILY / EQUIFEST OPEN RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND

Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C and D. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Rider any age. This class may be divided as appropriate

Class 16 - <u>Ridden Section C/D</u> (Will split if entries allow)

Class 17 - EQUIFEST RIDDEN PART BREDS

Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over exceeding 148cm. Exhibits in this section must be registered in the Part Bred section of their respective Breed Society. Registration numbers must be stated on the entry form. Horses and ponies will not be ridden at the final. Riders any age. Classes may be divided as appropriate.

- Class 18 Ridden Veteran
- Class 19 Ridden Anglo/ Part bred Arabs (any height/age)
- Class 20 Ridden Pure bred Arab
- Class 21 Ridden Foreign Breeds (excl Arabs)
- Class 22 Ridden Sports Horse any height/age
- Class 23 Ridden show cob

Class 3 - <u>EQUIFEST IN HAND RIDING PONIES</u> In hand Riding Ponies, stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding. Any age, not to exceed 153cms at maturity. Classes may be divided according to entries.

Class 4 <u>- BSPA / EQUIFEST IN HAND PIEBALD / SKEWBALD</u> Open in Hand Piebald / Skewbald stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age. The first three places will also qualify for the BSPA Championships. Subject to their show rules & conditions. Classes may be divided according to entries.

Class 5 - Welsh Section A / Welsh Section B.

Class 6 - Welsh Section C / Welsh Section D.

Class 7 - Part Bred Horse/Pony: Any Height.

Class 8 - SPILLERS / EQUIFEST MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND IN HAND

Open to In Hand Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C and D. Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age. This class may be divided as appropriate. Open to In Hand Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C and D. Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age. This class may be devided as appropriate.

Class 9 - Best Pony: 14.2hh and Under.

Class 10 - Arabs Pure Bred

Class 11- Arabs Part Bred including Anglo

Class 12 - Sports horse any height

Class 13 - Veteran: Horse/Pony over 15 Years

Class 14 - Foreign Breeds (any age/any height) excl Arabs

Class 15 - Shetland ponies any age

Class 16 - Coloured, Palomino, Spotted any height/age

TGCA TOYS In Hand and Ridden Classes. Show Number TGCA/06/17/068

These classes are qualifiers for the Best of Breed Finals at the Traditional Gypsy Cob Association's (TGCA) National Breed Championship Show "TOYS". Classes are open to all traditional gypsy cobs. Top three in each class qualify. In open height classes, top three in small and large sections qualify. Stallions – All stallions (four years and over) in order to enter any TGCA affiliated class MUST have their TGCA stallion disc displayed on their bridle. Existing TGCA members must present their qualification card to the judge in the ring for signature. Non members will receive a qualification card from the judge and will have 21 days to join the TGCA and to register their horse to validate the qualification. Please refer to www.tgca.co.uk for further details including membership, horse registration and showing rules (contained within the members handbook).

Quest Championship Shows

1st, 2nd and 3rd from the TGCA classes may go forward to the Quest for a Star Championship, provided they are current TGCA members and the horse is TGCA registered. Membership cards and qualification cards (specific to that exhibit) must be presented upon entry into the ring. The Champion and Reserve qualify for the Ultimate Star Championships at TOYS.

Classes will commence at 12pm - Judge Mrs K Neal

All classes are open to all traditional gypsy cobs, which are of any colour and which meet the TGCA breed standard.

In Hand Youngstock

Open to fillies colts and geldings aged 1, 2 and 3 Years old

In Hand Senior

Open to mares, stallions and geldings aged 4 years and over, any height. This class can be split into two height classes: Small - not to exceed 148 cm Large - 148 cm and above..

Ridden

Ridden Open to mares, stallions and geldings aged 4 years and over. This class can be split into two classes: Small - not to exceed 148 cm Large - 148 cm and above.

PEN Y GRAIG LIVERY FARM SHOW RULES

1) The organisers and venue owners accept no liability for anything that may happen to competitors, on lookers, their servants, their horses/ponies or any other property in connection with this or arising out this show.

2) All children must be **SUPERVISED** at all times whilst on the showground.

3) All competitors traveling horses/ponies to the showground are reminded that passports are to be carried with them.

4) All Stallions and Colts are welcome *BUT* must have liability insurance and also MUST be handled/ridden by a responsible adult at all times. Stallion & colts aged 2 years and over must be correctly bitted, with exception of miniature horses and those of a foreign breed who may be shown in their breed attire.

5) Any complaint must be in writing within 15 minutes of the class ending and be accompanied by £15.00. This will be refunded if the compliant is upheld.
6) All horses/ponies must be 4 years and over to compete in ridden classes or to be ridden anywhere outside the ring.

7) Riding hats must be worn to the current standard and must be worn at all times whilst mounted anywhere on the showground. All juniors must wear their riding hats at all times when handling their ponies this includes in hand classes and must have a 3 point harness. Failure to comply will result in the offender being asked to leave.

8) Lorries/trailers must not be muck out on to the showground or parking area.9) Schooling whips are not permitted in any class; Spurs are not to be worn by children 16 years and under.

10) In lead rein classes the lead rein must be attached to the noseband. *Riders in lead rein classes are not allowed to enter any other class off the lead rein (unless stated)*.

11) The committee reserves the right to remove any unfit Horse or Pony from the showground.

12) Pen y Graig Livery Farm will not tolerate bad language, misbehaviour, misuse of or cruelty to any animal. Offenders will be escorted from the showground.

13) No Horse/Pony tied to Lorries or Trailers or Vehicles are to be left unattended.

14) The committee reserves the right to cancel, amalgamate, add, alter, or change any class.

15) Whilst the organisers will do everything within their power to avoid any clash of classes for competitors, it is inevitable that this may happen; it is for the competitor to consider this when entering classes. **Entries for classes missed due to the above will not be refunded.**

16) All horses and ponies must **WALK ONLY** outside ring areas. Failure to adhere will result in competitor being asked to leave the showground

17) Entrance's to the rings <u>ARE TO KEPT CLEAR AT ALL TIMES.</u>

18) ALL DOGS SHOULD BE KEPT ON THEIR LEADS AT ALL TIMES
